School Superintendent and Board Member to Speak at the McLean Community Center

Dr. Scott Braband, the Fairfax County Public Schools (FCPS) Superintendent, and Ms. Elaine Tholen, the Dranesville District Representative on the School Board, will be addressing a community forum at the McLean Community Center on Monday, March 16th. They are encouraging students to ask questions. Ms. Tholen has said that she will come back to Longfellow in April and hold a forum as well.

Principal Kihm's School Update

- The McLean Center for the Arts is exhibiting the school pyramid's artwork. Students have done artwork through their graphic art and other art classes and some have won Golden Key & Silver Key awards.
- Because of Coronavirus concerns, the school administration canceled the China Exchange Program after a
 meeting with principals in the school pyramid and the School Superintendent. There is a panel of health officials
 who put together a bulletin that comes into principals from FCPS' Health Department every day at 5pm. Right
 now, domestic trips are still on. School administration and teachers are encouraging students to wash their
 hands and use hand sanitizer when necessary. The school is putting information on the news show, have signs in
 the hallways, and teachers are allowing students to use the bathroom more often if they need to wash their
 hands.
